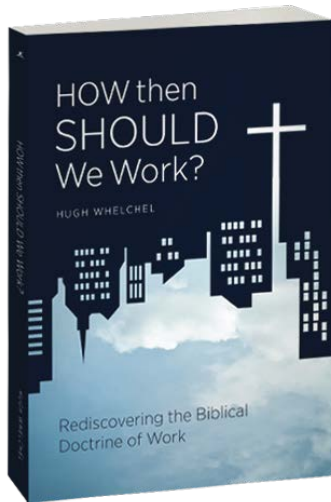
Does what you do at work have value to God?
